

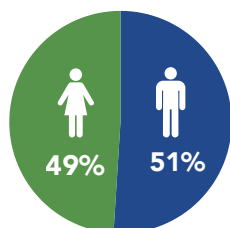

of patients are alive five years after an AYA cancer diagnosis

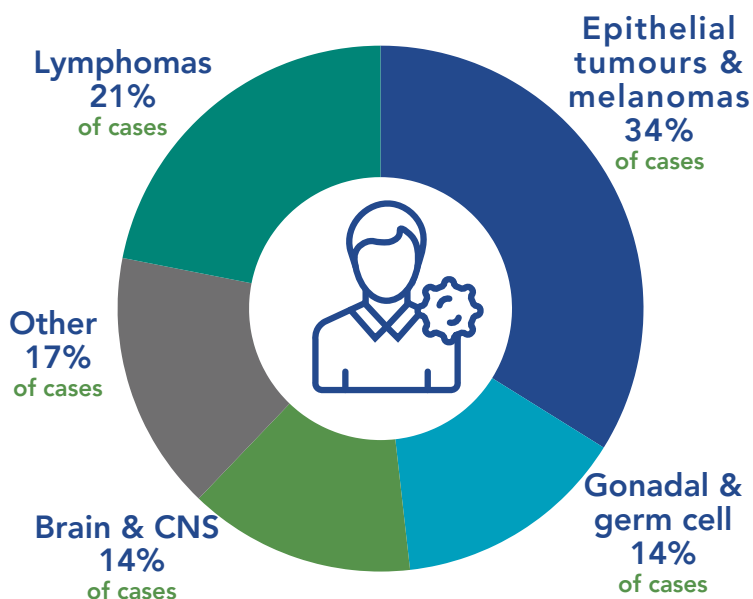
